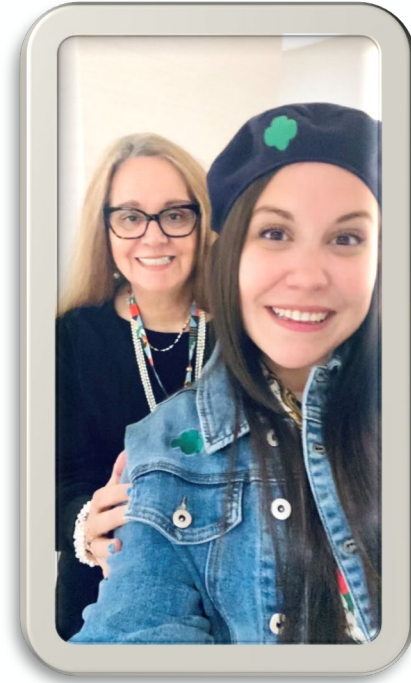

# Registration Lingo

## Delegation Registration

- The pathway council/delegate liaisons will use to register attendees who are attending convention on behalf of their council and whose registration is being completed and paid for by the council.
- Includes the following registration types: Delegates, Alternates, Council Staff (including Council/Delegate Liaisons), Council CEOs, Council Board Members and Adult or Girl Members council chooses to pay for/sponsor.
- This is a separate portal from public registration. It will be accessible from a direct link provided to liaisons or from a “delegation registration” button on the Registration Types page on the Convention Registration website.



# Registration Lingo

## Early Bird

- The special rate that applies for anyone who registers through the public portal between July 20<sup>th</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>.
  - Pricing used in the Delegation Registration reflects the same savings available through the Early Bird pricing (\$50 savings/attendee).
- Early Bird pricing for the public ends on October 31<sup>st</sup> at 11:59pm ET and General Registration pricing will be in effect for the remainder of the registration period.
- As a reminder, the “Early Bird” savings of \$50/attendee will be applied to the Delegation Registration tickets\* for the entire Delegation Registration timeframe, beginning in November 2023.
  - \*Delegates are not eligible for the discounted pricing due to specific perks included in their ticket price.



# Registration Time Frames

## Early Bird

- Open July 20<sup>th</sup>, 2022 – October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022
- Available to all attendees registering through the public portal

## General Registration

- Open November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022 – June 2023
- Available to all attendees registering through the public portal

## Delegation Registration

- Open November 2022 – June 2023
- Pricing offered through Delegation Registration will reflect the Early Bird savings throughout the entire registration period.

# Hotels & Transportation

**There will be two Disney resorts with room blocks available through GSUSA: Disney's Contemporary Resort and Disney's Coronado Springs Resort.**

- Rooms will be reserved from the overall room block inventory for Delegation Registration which opens in late November. This inventory will be held for councils until (date to be determined) and then will be released to all attendees to book.
  - A form will be sent out next week to all council/delegate liaisons to submit their anticipated room block for attendees they are registering through Delegation Registration. This form is due by July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
    - This form will include requests for suites. All suites are by request only and are subject to availability.
  - Councils will not be able to hold rooms for those registering through the public portal.
- All rooms booked within the convention room block require a deposit equivalent to one night's stay due at time of booking. The remaining balance for the room will be due at check-in.
  - This deposit will apply to hotel rooms councils book for their delegation.

# Hotels & Transportation (Cont.)

## Pricing

- **Coronado Springs Resort:**
  - Run of House (two queens or one king) - \$219/night
  - Suites - \$369/night
  - Rooms are double capacity
    - Additional persons in room over age of 18 - \$25/person a night
  - Standard Overnight Parking Fee - \$20/night
- **Contemporary Resort:**
  - Run of house (two queens or one king) - \$299/night
  - No suites are available
  - Room are double capacity
    - Additional persons in room over age of 18 - \$25/person a night
  - Standard Overnight Parking Fee - \$25/night

Resort fees for both Coronado Springs and Contemporary have been waived

Prices do not include tax (we have contacted Disney to request tax rates)

# Hotels & Transportation (Cont.)

- Shoulder nights will be available to book for attendees who want to arrive early or depart late (subject to availability at time of booking).
  - We are working with the hotel to finalize dates of the shoulder nights and the reservation + billing process.
- Food and Beverage will be available for purchase throughout the resort properties.
  - Those registered as delegates will have some meals provided to them throughout the National Council Session. They will be notified in advance of what meals these will be.
    - No other registration types are included in the meals provided by GSUSA

# Hotels & Transportation (Cont.)

- We will be providing transportation for attendees at no cost between the Contemporary and Coronado Springs Resorts for Convention related activities.
  - Most of Convention activities will be taking place at Coronado Springs – including National Council Session.
  - Those looking for transportation outside of event hours will need to use Disney transportation services, ride share services, or a rental car.
- Airport Transportation – This is the responsibility of whomever is booking the travel for the attendee (whether that be council or the individual).
  - Sunshine Flyer – Disney’s Airport Transfer Service (\$32/person Roundtrip)
  - Ride Share Services
  - Rental Car

# FAQs

If an attendee registers and then becomes a delegate, what happens?

The attendee will be reimbursed for their registration fee and their deposit for their hotel stay (if applicable).

We are still determining the best process for this in our system and will provide an update ASAP.

# When will the GSUSA website be updated to reflect all the exciting news around 2023 Convention?

We are working hard to build our 2023 Convention Registration site as well as update our GSUSA Convention page to provide the best user experience. The exact release date for these updates is TBD.

# How do we find out what speakers will be at 2023 Convention?

Our 2023 Convention Registration website will be updated on a regular basis as we have new information to share about the event. We plan to have a dedicated section on the site where attendees can learn about the speakers for the event!
