Girl Scouts Love State Parks / Girl Scouts Love the Outdoors Challenge (All Levels)

Cost: \$5 per person, plus park admission

Individual day passes are \$8 per adult, \$5 for military or kids ages 5–15, free for kids under 4. Annual passes (valid for all occupants in a vehicle) are \$99 per year, \$49.50 military, or free to check out from the public library.

Girls will accompany Park Ranger Rachel on a hike from the Nature Center at the pier to Boneyard Beach and finish the afternoon making s'mores. Participants will receive a Girl Scouts Love State Parks patch and will also complete 11 of the activities from the Girl Scouts Love the Outdoors Challenge. ([See full activity sheet](#))

Pre-registration and pre-payment of park admission required.

Must pre-register and pre-pay park admission. Hike and s'mores activity has a limit of 30 participants per day. Troop leaders/registered volunteers are included in the 30-person limit, and we ask that each troop limit attendance to 2 adults. Open to Beaufort County only until August 25, then surrounding counties will be invited to register. Tagalongs are welcome to attend and enjoy the park, but will only be able to participate in the hike and s'mores if there is extra space available.

Cost: \$4 per girl

Includes age-appropriate first aid training based upon badge requirements and the First Aid badge. CPR certification card not provided. Seat limits vary by location — see below.
