

## Cadette, Senior and Ambassador Service to Girl Scouting Bar National Leadership Awards







Dear Cadette, Senior, Ambassador Girl Scout,

When you earn a Service to Girl Scouting Bar award, you are making a difference within your Girl Scout community by practicing the values of the Girl Scout Law. This is a great opportunity to be more involved in girl scouting.

If you choose to earn the Service to Girl Scouting Bar you will need to volunteer at least 20 hours to the Girl Scout organization as a Cadette, Senior, or Ambassador. There are many ways you can volunteer with Girl Scouts of Eastern South Carolina. For example, you might volunteer your time at a special event for younger girls, be an office assistant for your council or service unit, or help with special projects. Council approval is not needed before beginning, but be sure to submit your Service to Girl Scouting Bar Application and time log after completion of your hours.

After you have completed your 20 hours of community service with your chosen organization you will need to fill out this form and submit it to Crystal Osborne via email at <u>cosborne@gsesc.org</u>, in person, or by post at the Council Service Center 7257 Cross County Rd., North Charleston, SC 29418. Please be sure all sections are completed before submission.

Once your application has been reviewed and verified your leader will receive an email confirming that you have met the requirements to earn your Service to Girl Scouting Bar. Your leader can purchase the Service to Girl Scouting Bar to present to you at a troop meeting, or opt to have you presented with it at our annual Girl Recognition event that is held in April.
